Dear Families:

This Sunday we read the Gospel of the GOOD SHEPHERD. Jesus is the Good Shepherd, always attentive and vigilant to the needs of his flock. We are his sheep, his friends, and his disciples. He knows us by name and knows us deeply. He knows our whims and our fears, our strengths and our shortcomings and, although we fail him many times, He still keeps us in his flock.

There is a relationship between Jesus as shepherd, and we as His sheep: we spend time together, we know each other; He never stops looking after and caring for us, He talks to us, and we hear Him today, but tomorrow, we cover our ears or prefer to listen to other pastors; then we turn to Him when we are in need, and He is always there waiting for us because He loves us. We are His family.

Being sheep of the Good Shepherd is following in His footsteps. The shepherd "...walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they recognize his voice..." (Jn 10:4). At the Last Supper Jesus said: "...I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do..." (Jn 13:15).

The Good Shepherd feeds His sheep. The normal duty of the shepherd is to lead the sheep in search of pastures to feed and running water to quench their thirst. Jesus said He came so that His sheep "...might have life and have it more abundantly..." (Jn 10:10). And, surprisingly, the food that the Good Shepherd gives His sheep is His own body and His own blood: "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink" (John 6:54-55).

The Good Shepherd's sheep shall not perish forever. The shepherd's job is to defend His sheep against wolves. "A hired man, who is not a shepherd and whose sheep are not his own, sees a wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away, and the wolf catches and scatters them" (Jn 10:12).

Christ, the Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep (John 10:11). That is why He says that His sheep "...shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand" (Jn 10:28). "...and this is the will of the One who sent me, that I should not lose anything of what He gave me, but that I should raise it on the last day..." (Jn 6:39). "I am the bread of life. Whoever eats this bread will live forever" (Jn 6:48-51).

Pray for our bishops and Pope Francis; pray for your priests to be shepherds of the people (universal Church, Diocese, parishes), following the example of the Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ, who loved us to the point of giving His life for us.

I bless you all, I love you. As your pastor, I hold all of you in my heart.

Queridas Familias:

Leemos en este domingo el Evangelio del BUEN PASTOR. Jesús es el Buen Pastor atento y vigilante a las necesidades de sus ovejas. Nosotros somos sus ovejas, sus amigos, sus discípulos. Nos conoce por nuestro nombre y nos conoce profundamente. Sabe de nuestros caprichos y de nuestros temores, de nuestras virtudes y nuestros defectos y, a pesar de que le fallamos muchas veces, El nos sigue guardando en su rebaño.

Existe una relación entre Jesús, como pastor, y nosotros, como sus ovejas: pasamos tiempo juntos, nos conocemos; El no deja de mirarnos y cuidarnos, nos habla; nosotros le escuchamos hoy, pero mañana nos tapamos los oídos o preferimos escuchar a otros pastores; después acudimos a El cuando estamos necesitados, y El siempre está ahí esperándonos porque nos ama. Somos su familia.

Ser ovejas del Buen Pastor es seguir sus pasos. El pastor "va delante de ellas y las ovejas le siguen, porque conocen su voz" (Jn 10:4). Y en la última cena Jesús dijo: "Les he dado ejemplo para que hagan lo mismo que Yo hice con ustedes" (Jn 13:15).

El Buen Pastor alimenta a sus ovejas. Corresponde al oficio normal del pastor conducir las ovejas en busca de pastos con que alimentarlas, y a corrientes de agua para abreviarlas. Jesús aseguró que ha venido para que sus ovejas "tengan vida y la tengan abundante" (Jn 10:10). Y, sorprendentemente, el alimento que el Buen Pastor proporciona a sus ovejas es su propio cuerpo y su propia sangre: "El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna y yo le resucitaré en el último día. Porque mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida" (Jn 6:54 y siguiente).

Las ovejas del Buen Pastor no perecerán para siempre. El trabajo del pastor es defender sus ovejas contra los lobos. "El asalariado, que no es pastor y dueño de las ovejas, abandona las ovejas y huye, y el lobo hace estragos y las dispersa" (Jn 10:12).

Cristo, el Buen Pastor, da la vida por las ovejas (Jn 10:11). Por eso dice que sus ovejas "no perecerán para siempre, nadie las arrebatará de su mano" (Jn 10:28). Porque ésta es la voluntad del que me ha enviado: que no pierda nada de lo que él me ha dado, sino que lo resucite en el último día" (Jn 6:39). "Yo soy el pan de vida.....Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre" (Jn 6:48-51).

Recen por nuestros obispos y el Papa Francisco; recen por sus sacerdotes para que sean pastores del pueblo (Iglesia universal, Diócesis, parroquias) siguiendo el ejemplo del Buen Pastor, Cristo Jesús, que nos amó hasta dar la vida por nosotros.

A todos los bendigo, los amo y los llevo en mi corazón de sacerdote.


