## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

April 9, 2017

Is 50:4-7; Ph 2:6-11; Mt 26:14-27:66  
Psalm 22

Dear Families:

The gospel according to Matthew is read today during the blessing of the Palms and it describes the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. This is the week that **Jesus dies on the Cross**. The Passion of Christ according to St. Matthew is also read today.

**Holy Week** imposes to all faithful Christians a sense of respect, an invitation to prayer, a need to be charitable and to reflect upon their lives. On the other hand, there are many Christians who just take this week for granted, as if it had no meaning. The Church makes an urgent appeal for us to participate and help others participate in these days of celebration of these mysteries. Children are educated not only from books, but by seeing, by participating and by being present at the celebration of these mysteries. I have watched with sorrow and yet with pity as there are young people who have never been to the **Church during Holy Week**; they do not know about the **washing of the feet** and what it symbolizes; they are unaware of the **Last Supper**, the **Adoration of the Cross**, the **Easter Vigil**, or the true meaning of **Easter**. If you were to ask what Easter is, you would probably get many different answers. We need to emphasize the importance of living and celebrating the mysteries of our salvation as part of our faith. In knowing the history of God's love for us, we can guide our lives easier in the ways of God. Courage! Let us help others celebrate and live their faith during these holy days!

**Holy Thursday:** Celebration of the Last Supper of the Lord; the commandment of love, symbolized in the washing of the feet, the institution of the Eucharist, Communion, the Mass; and Jesus' request to do all this in His memory.

**Good Friday:** The Church invites us to focus on the Cross. Jesus died on it and through it brought forth our salvation. The Word of God invites us on this day to reflect upon the passion of Christ. We worship the Cross.

**Holy Saturday:** Easter Vigil. This is the Holy Night par excellence, the most desired of the year, when Jesus resurrected triumphantly and with **Him**, everyone who believes in **Him**. It is a night of light (candles are lit and the Easter candle symbolizes **Christ, the Light of the World**) and joy for all Christians, who have been rescued by Christ in baptism, and made children of God and of the light, not darkness. It is Easter, the day the Lord saves us. **Let us live in the spiritual happiness and joy of the true children of God!**

## Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor

9 de Abril del 2017

Is 50:4-7; Fil 2:6-11; Mt 26:14-27:66  
Salmo 22 [21]

Queridas Familias:

El evangelio de Mateo que hoy leemos durante la bendición de los Ramos nos describe la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. En esa misma semana muere **Jesús en la Cruz**. Hoy se lee también la Pasión de Cristo según nos lo relata San Mateo.

A todo cristiano con fe la **Semana Santa** le impone respeto, le invita a la oración, le sugiere hacer alguna obra de caridad, le hace reflexionar sobre su vida. Pero hay muchos cristianos que pasan de largo en esta semana, como si no existiera. La Iglesia nos hace un llamamiento urgentísimo a participar y ayudar a otros a que participen en estos días de la celebración de estos misterios. Los niños se educan no sólo por los libros, sino viendo las cosas, participando en ellas, estando presentes en la celebración de los misterios de estos días. He observado con pena y a la vez con lástima como hay jóvenes que nunca han estado en la **Iglesia en la Semana Santa**; no saben que es el **lavatorio de los pies** y lo que simboliza; no saben de la **Última Cena**; no saben nada de la **adoración de la Cruz**; no saben nada de la **Vigilia Pascual**; y acerca de **Pascua** no saben lo que el nombre significa. Si ustedes preguntan qué es **Easter**, no recibirán muchas respuestas correctas. Tenemos que insistir en lo fundamental que es para la vida del ser humano el vivir y celebrar la fe en los misterios de nuestra salvación. Conociendo la historia del amor de Dios por nosotros, más fácilmente guiamos nuestras vidas por los caminos de Dios. ¡Animo! Ayudemos para que muchos celebren y vivan la fe de estos días santos.

**Jueves Santo:** Celebración de la Última Cena de Jesús; del mandamiento del Amor, simbolizado en el lavatorio de los pies; de la institución de la Eucaristía, la Comunió, la Misa; y el encargo de Jesús de hacer todo esto en memoria suya.

**Viernes Santo:** La Iglesia nos invita a centrar la atención en la Cruz. En ella muere Jesús, de ella nace la salvación. La Palabra de Dios nos invita en este día a meditar en el dolor de Cristo. Adoramos la Cruz.

**Sábado Santo:** Vigilia Pascual. Esta es la Noche Santa por excelencia, en que Jesús resucita victorioso y con **El** todos los que creen en **El**. Es noche de luz (las velas encendidas y el gran Cirio Pascual que simboliza a **Christo, luz del mundo** y de gozo para todos los cristianos, pues rescatados en el Bautismo por Cristo, somos hijos de Dios y de la luz, no de las tinieblas. Es Pascua, el paso del Señor salvándonos.

We cannot listen to or believe the Gospel of the passion without marveling at how much God loves each human life, and without feeling impelled to respond when that same human life is trampled underfoot. Calvary continues today as innocent people are killed in abortion clinics.
