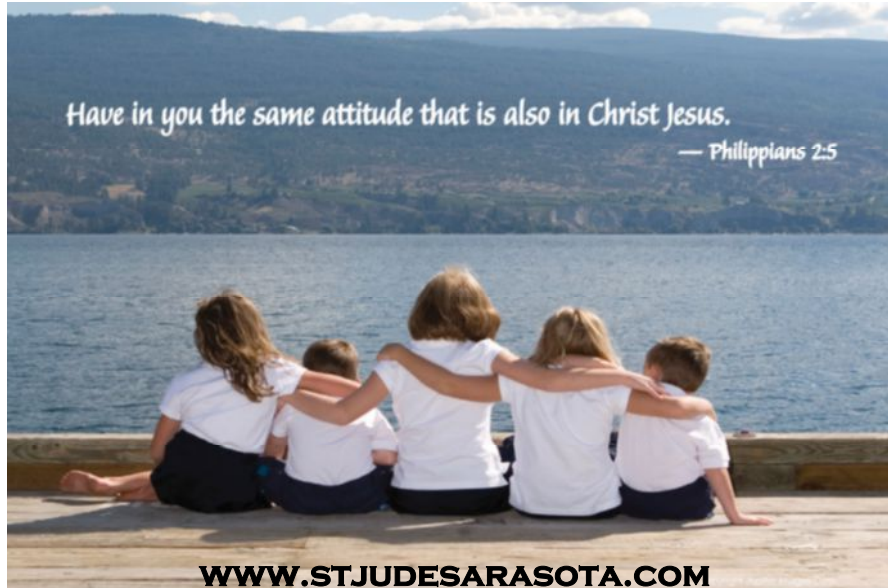

Dear Families:

Every year, the Church, as the mother of all Christians, places special emphasis on respect for LIFE. We live in a society so materialistic that it has reached a point of moral degradation where it does not mind disposing of human lives that it considers to be annoying. We are psychologically "pressured" to accept the horrific propositions of an industry dedicated to killing lives before they can see the light enjoyed by millions of human beings. Slogans like: "Babies are noisy, smelly, and expensive"; they are a "parasitic disease"; "A goldfish resembles a human being more than an embryo does"; unborn babies are "protoplasmic rubbish"; "A goblet of meat" are, sadly, typical of today's mentality. A professor at Princeton University has taken this thought to its logical conclusion, to degrade the newborn child: "Human babies are not born self-aware, and are not capable of understanding the world they exist in. They are not persons. To some, the life of a newborn is of less value than that of a pig, a dog, or a chimpanzee.

This notion is being put forth, in order to get us to stop seeing human life as God sees it. From the moment of conception, God does not see us as an undifferentiated microscopic cell. Rather, in every child, whether born or to be born, God sees the individual He created. Someone to love and be loved, for all eternity.

Let us pray for LIFE, work in favor of LIFE, and be witnesses in the defense of LIFE. For forty days, we will pray without ceasing for this mission of the Church of Christ from September 27 to November 5. I invite you to join those who have committed to pray in front of the abortion center and have decided to make this testimonial march and to bear witness of our faith. God will bless you and your children.

How different are God's ways from ours! Amiable and kind to all, the Lord is equally generous in compassion and love both to those who are quick to respond to His invitation, as well as with those who are slow to hear His call. May the Lord Jesus always be in your life.

Queridas Familias:

Cada año la Iglesia, como madre de todos los cristianos, llama la atención con fuerza acerca del respeto a la VIDA. Vivimos en una sociedad tan materializada que ha llegado a un punto de degradación moral tal que no le importa deshacerse de vidas humanas que le son molestas. Estamos presionados psicológicamente para aceptar los postulados horribles de una industria dedicada a matar vidas antes de ver la luz de la que disfrutamos millones de seres humanos. Estos son algunos eslogans: "Los bebés son ruidosos, apesados, caros, a menos que se desee uno son una enfermedad parasitaria"; "Un pez dorado se parece más a un ser humano que un embrión humano"; "Basura protoplásmica"; "Un trozo de carne". Un profesor de la Universidad de Princeton ha llevado este pensamiento hasta su conclusión lógica, para degradar al niño recién nacido: "Los bebés humanos no nacen conscientes de sí mismos, ni son capaces de comprender que existen en el tiempo. No son personas. Por lo tanto la vida de un recién nacido es de menor valor que la de un cerdo, un perro, o un chimpancé".

Es así como nos estamos dando cuenta de que dejemos de ver la vida humana como Dios la ve. Desde el momento de nuestra concepción Dios no nos ve superficialmente como una célula microscópica no diferenciada. En cada niño nacido o por nacer, Dios ve al individuo que Él crea para amar y ser amado, por toda la eternidad.

Recemos por la VIDA, trabajemos a favor de la VIDA, seamos testigos de la defensa de la VIDA. Durante cuarenta días vamos a orar sin descanso para esta misión de la Iglesia de Cristo del 27 de septiembre hasta el 5 de noviembre. Los invito a que se unan a aquellos que se comprometen a rezar frente a la clínica de aborto en 736 Central Ave. en Sarasota y que voluntariamente deciden hacer esta marcha testimonial y dar testimonio de nuestra fe. Dios bendecir sus vidas y la de sus hijos.
