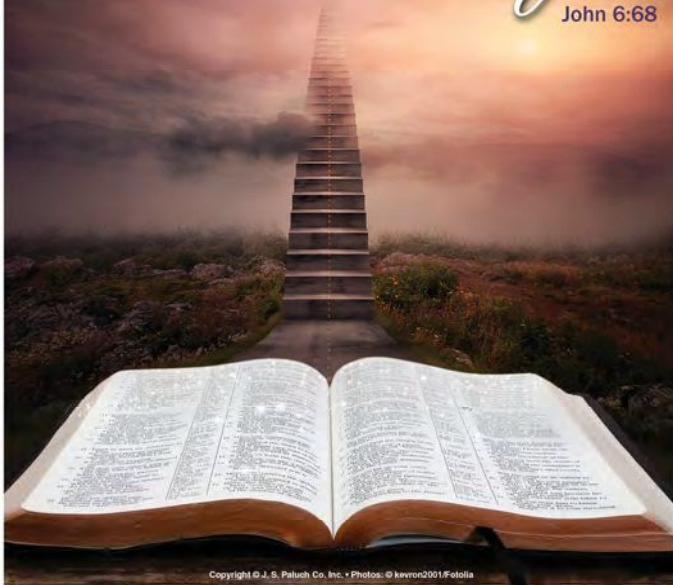

Dear Families:

This Sunday's readings invite us to reaffirm our faith and trust in the words of Peter: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life". This is a question that comes up frequently in everyone's life. Why does Peter talk like that? To remind us that we must continuously place and renew our faith in God. There are always unusual situations and events that require us to continuously take positions as Christians.

To be nourished by the bread that Jesus promises, when we receive the Eucharist, is the equivalent of getting in tune with Jesus in order to understand and accept His proposals, His thoughts, His way of being and acting.

After the story of the multiplication of the loaves, Jesus proposes His great Eucharistic catechesis and, when finished, the Evangelist John recounts the disbelief of his listeners. The Eucharist does not eliminate conflicts.

The nourishment for those who want to be saved is at the Lord's table. This is where the bread of salvation is for sinners.

Most people who have followed Jesus do not understand His words and can sometimes misinterpret them. As a result, they abandon Jesus and His apostles because His doctrine on the "bread of life" is totally different from what they expected. And it is not only about the teachings of Jesus, but also about His very person: many walk away completely disappointed.

We too can reach a point where we fabricate a Christ according to our tastes and whims. We accept what we like of Him, but we set aside His demands, particularly His cross. We find the Christ of the Gospel and the Church to be a bit exaggerated and we seek "one that is more pleasant."

Today, as always, we need to remember the words of Peter: "To whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life".

Vigésimo Primer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Queridas Familias:

Las lecturas de este Domingo nos invitan a reafirmar nuestra fe y nuestra confianza en las palabras de Pedro: "Señor, ¿a quién iremos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna". Esta es una pregunta que aparece con frecuencia en la vida de todos. ¿Por qué Pedro habla así? Para recordarnos que la fe en Dios debemos ponerla y renovarla continuamente. Siempre se dan situaciones y hechos insólitos que nos exigen continuamente tomar posiciones como cristianos.

Nutrirnos del pan que Jesús promete, al recibir la Eucaristía, equivale a entrar en sintonía con Jesús para poder entender y aceptar sus propuestas, sus pensamientos, sus modos de ser y de actuar.

Después de la narración de la multiplicación de los panes, Jesús propone su gran catequesis eucarística y, al terminar, el evangelista San Juan relata las relaciones de la incredulidad de sus oyentes. La Eucaristía no elimina los conflictos.

En la mesa del Señor está el alimento de aquellos que se quieren salvar. Está el pan de salvación para los pecadores.

La mayoría de la gente que ha seguido a Jesús no comprende sus palabras y las malinterpreta y se va; y abandona a Jesús y a sus apóstoles porque su doctrina sobre el "pan de vida" es totalmente diferente de lo que ellos esperaban. Y no se trata únicamente de las enseñanzas de Jesús, sino de su persona misma: muchos se alejan completamente decepcionados.

También nosotros podemos llegar a fabricarnos un Cristo según nuestros gustos y caprichos. Aceptamos lo que de él nos gusta, pero dejamos a un lado sus exigencias, en particular su cruz. Nos parece un poco exagerado el Cristo del Evangelio y de la Iglesia y buscamos "a otro más agradable."

Hoy como siempre, es necesario recordar las palabras de Pedro: "¿a quién iremos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna".

Que Dios los Bendiga.
